

## To our valued customers and friends:

*Our customers' and employees' health is our first and foremost concern during the COVID-19 pandemic. We have instituted the following operational guidelines after consulting the Office of Pennsylvania Gov. Tom Wolf, the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, the National Association of Theatre Owners, and the National Association of Theatre Owners of Pennsylvania. We remain in contact with these agencies daily for any changes.*

### FOR OUR CUSTOMERS

- Any customers who are COVID-19 positive or have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 within the past 14 days are prohibited from entering the building.
- **You must wear a face mask** covering your mouth and nose to enter the building. Per food establishment guidelines, **you may remove your mask when seated in a theater or at a table in our dining room.** You must put it back on when leaving your seat.
- **You must stay 6 feet** away from other people when in any line. Guidance signs/markings are in place throughout the building to remind you of the requirement for social distancing.
- Per current state restrictions, dining room seating is limited to **25% of maximum capacity.** Outdoor seating is available, and no-contact curbside takeout is available by calling ahead.
- Per current state restrictions, seating is limited to **25 people or less in each of our theaters.**
- Seating requirements: If your group arrives together, you may sit together. For others, social distancing of 6 feet is required. Our theater requirement for distancing is at least three empty seats in a row (72") OR 1 row apart (40") and two seats apart (48")
- Customers who do not comply with these restrictions will be asked to comply. Those who continue to not comply must leave the building.

### FOR OUR CUSTOMERS' AND EMPLOYEES' SAFETY

- Employees are forbidden to work if they are COVID-19 positive or have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Employees arriving for their shifts are tested for a body temperature below 100.4 degrees and the absence of any shortness of breath or cough. If any of these symptoms appear, they are sent home before any interactions with customers.
- Employees are required to wear face masks covering their nose and mouth.
- All public areas of the building are thoroughly cleaned between shows using best practices from the agencies listed above.
- Any high-risk individual is encouraged to isolate at home.

*We will continue to operate within these policies until they are changed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.*
